For over 20 years Iron Cactus has been serving up delicious food along the Riverwalk. Located on historic Sixth Street you'll enjoy wonderful views of the river and great service. Iron Cactus serves up classic Mexican dishes for brunch, lunch and dinner. One of my favorites is the brisket quesadilla with roasted poblanos, caramelized onions and serrano raspberry bbq sauce, but that's just to start. If you're looking for a hearty meal before you explore San Antonio I would recommend the Cactus Filet. An 8oz filet with jumbo lump crabmeat, green chile bacon mash and seasonal veggies. Don't forget to order yourself a margarita while you're here. Iron Cactus Mexican Restaurant has been named one of the top 10 tequila bars in the country with over 100 different types of tequila.
