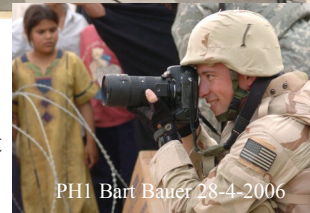
**100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Naval Photography:**

# Where Are My Pictures?

By Harry B. Kidd (PH2, 1963-1970)

Sailors have been taking photographs for the Navy for over 100 years. Today the National Archives, in College Park, Maryland, has approximately 2.4 million still pictures in its permanent collection. The collection includes images from 1795 through the early 2000s.

The earliest image, of course, aren't original photographs but are photographic copies of paintings, documents, and artifacts. In some cases the images in the collection may be the only record of items that have been damaged, destroyed or lost over time.

That is all very interesting, but you're asking what happened to the photos I took? All those grip and grins, broken parts reports, accidents, flag raisings, officer portraits, and thousands of other routine shooting assignments. Most of them never made it back to the Navy Department in Washington and those that did where reviewed historic value. As a general rule about 1% of the documents and images created by the government are retained in the permanent collection of the Archives.

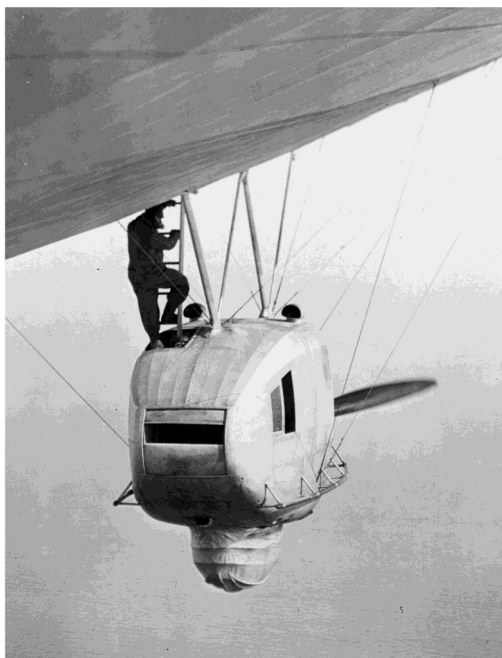
That's the sad news - most photos are discarded within a few years of their creation.

The good news that if a document or photograph is selected for inclusion in the Archives the goal is that it be keep forever. All the photographs at the Archives are available and you can make scans of the research copies. At present the Still Picture Research Room is open during normal business hours Monday - Saturday (except for the usual holidays, etc.)
