



Lieutenant Commander William "Mack" Jamieson

Public Affairs Officer, USS Harry S. Truman (CVN 75)

Lieutenant Commander Mack Jamieson is a native of Fulton, Mississippi. He graduated from the University of North Alabama with a bachelor's degree in history in 2008 and earned a master's degree in communication from San Diego State University in 2022.

Jamieson enlisted in the U.S. Navy in February 2009 and served five years as a Mass Communication Specialist before earning his commission through Officer Candidate School. He was commissioned as an ensign in May 2014.

His enlisted assignments included Navy Public Affairs Support Element East in Norfolk, Virginia, and Naval Support Activity Mid-South in Millington, Tennessee. While assigned to Navy Public Affairs Support Element East, Jamieson deployed aboard USS Dwight D. Eisenhower (CVN 69), USS Stephen W. Groves (FFG 29), USS Samuel B. Roberts (FFG 58) and USS Jason Dunham (DDG 109).

Following commissioning, Jamieson served aboard USS George H.W. Bush (CVN 77) as a Media Department division officer. During his tour, he completed a deployment and supported the ship through a planned incremental availability.

His shore assignments include serving as a lead planner for the Navy Week Program at the Navy Office of Community Outreach in Millington, Tennessee; public affairs officer for Commander, Submarine Group 9 in Bangor, Washington; and public affairs officer for Naval Service Training Command in Great Lakes, Illinois.

Jamieson reported to USS Harry S. Truman (CVN 75) in June 2025, where he currently serves as the ship's public affairs officer.

His personal decorations include the Meritorious Service Medal, three Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medals and three Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medals.
